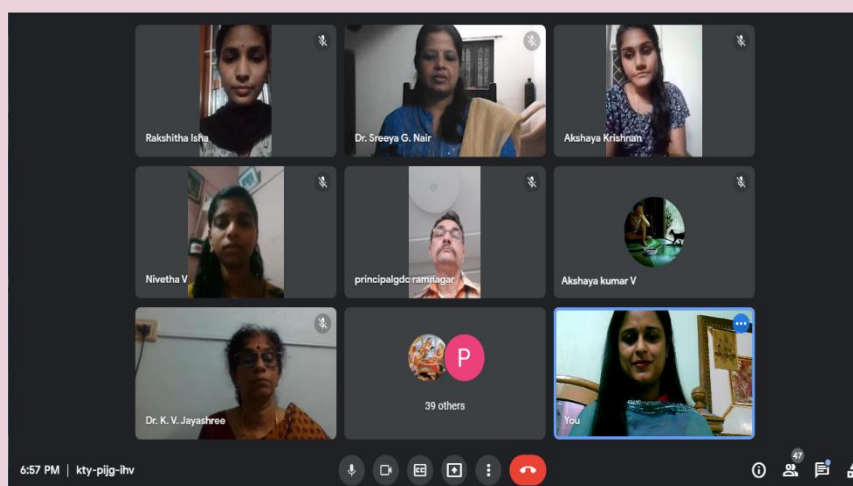
along with the NSS volunteers to address the people about the concerns related vaccine safety

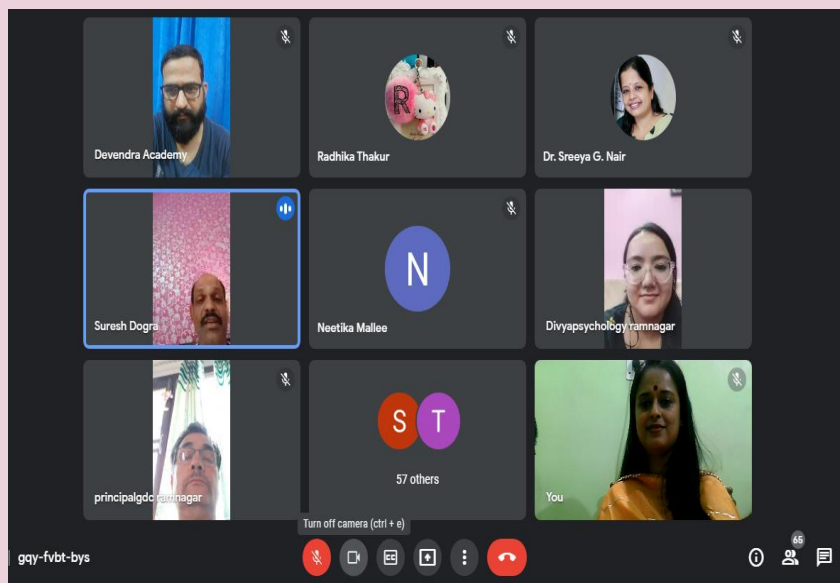

### **‘Best out of Waste’ on the occasion of ‘World Environment Day’ (5-6-21)**

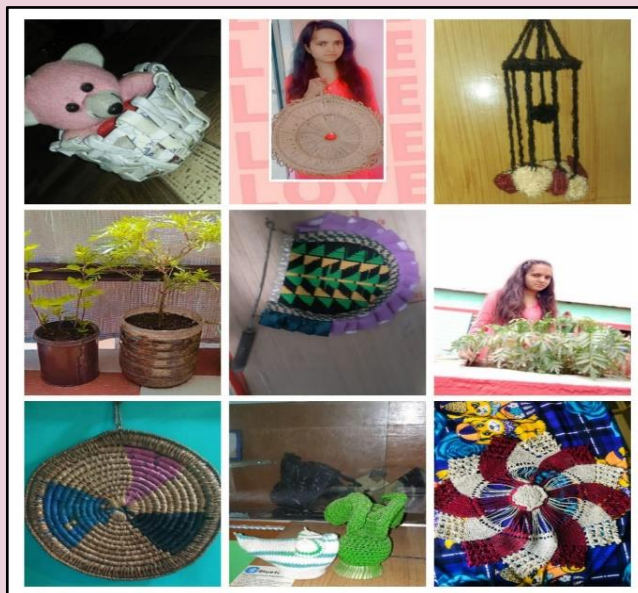

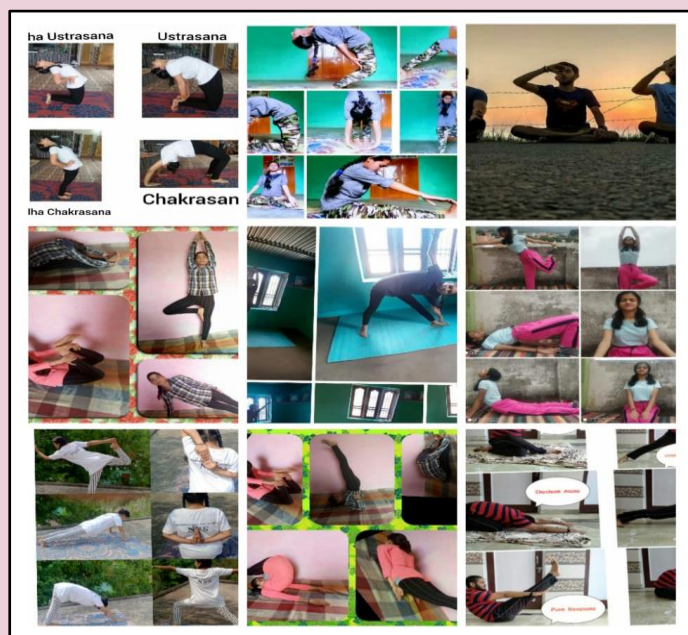
Programme officer.

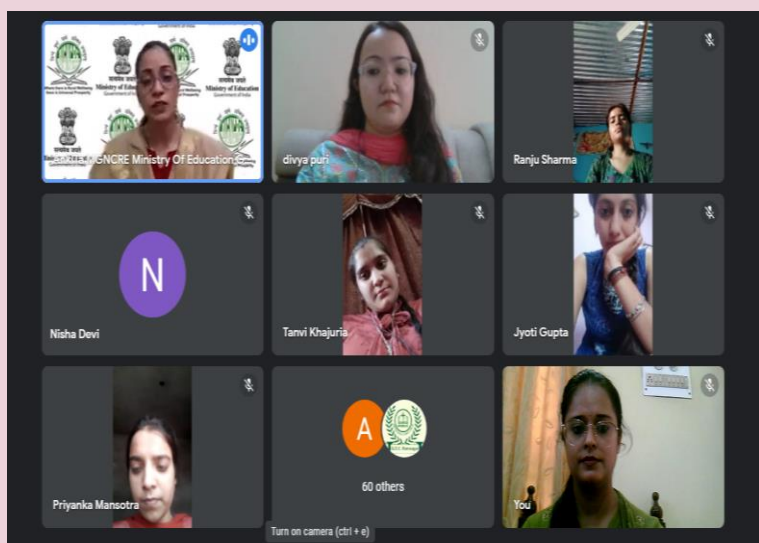

### **ACTIVITIES OF PSYCHOLOGICAL COUNSELLING CELL (MANODARPAN)**

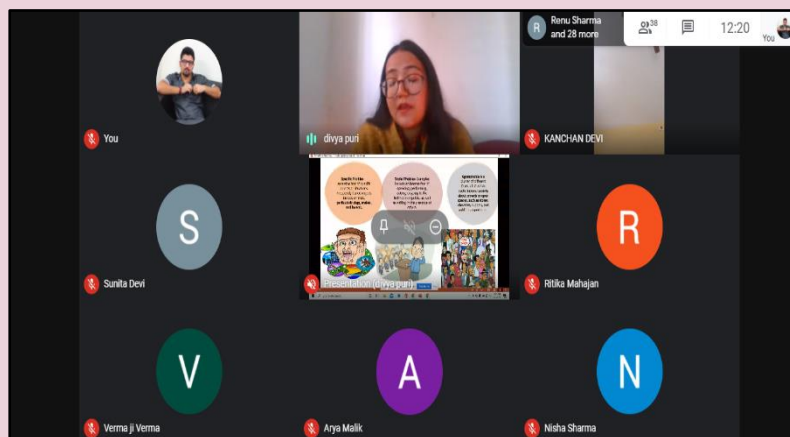
#### **Organized One day program on “Understanding and Managing Stress”**

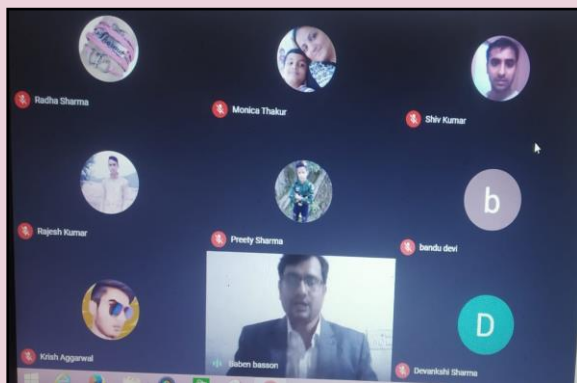
