PROGRAMME LEARNING OBJECTIVES IN B.A Political Science

- PO1: Students will come to understand that there are various types of political systems around the world, and that these may differ from each other with regard to their individual political institutions, political culture, political ideologies, and public policies.
- PO2: Students will become aware of the crucial questions raised by classical and contemporary political philosophers, and of some of the solutions proposed by them to answer fundamental questions about the role of politics in human life.
- PO3: Students will come to understand the means of inquiry in the social sciences generally, and in political science in particular. This will include an understanding of how knowledge about politics and government is generated by political scientists working within their discipline.
- PO4: Students will be prepared to take entry level jobs in the public or private sector or to undertake graduate study, whether academic (e.g., master's or doctoral programs in political science) or professional (e.g., law or public administration).
- PO5: Students will learn about the concepts, theories, and data needed to comprehend the interactions of nations that constitute international relations, and the nature of such global institutions as the United Nations, regional alliances, and international law.

PROGRAMME OBJECTIVES

- The program aims to provide students with the knowledge and skills through which they can deeply grasp political, cultural and economic developments at national and global level and acquire the qualifications sought in the national and global environment and labor markets.
- It also aims to provide students with a scientific understanding of social facts and phenomena that would enable them to uncover the roots of common perceptions and practices, to question them when necessary, and to come up with policy proposals when possible. Such a goal necessitates the students to be equipped with knowledge of political theory, history as well as of political economy and scientific methods in social sciences.
- To demonstrate theoretical and practical knowledge on political science and international relations and to state views and positions with advanced oral and written skills.
- To analyze national and global events from various social science perspectives.
- To compete for increasing career opportunities in national and global institutions.
